The glory of God is God in manifestation.

The glory of God is seen in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:6, 7

The veil is taken away in Christ.

2 Corinthians 3:11-16 when one turns to the Lord the veil is taken away.

*But we all, with unveiled face beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord. **2 Corinthians 3:18***

God speaks to us in His Son - The brightness of His glory and express image of His person.

Hebrews 1:1-5

Jesus received honor and glory from God the Father.

2 Peter 1:16-21

Inside Glory is the voice of God.

Honor and glory are given in His words on display. We behold, we speak. He manifests, and we hear. Glory is not of ourselves but of God.

When we glorify God, or when God is glorifying Himself, the effect is the same—Honor and glory in manifestation.

Trust in Christ is to the praise of His glory. The restoration of glory is trust in all relationships.
