

# The Glory of God and the Riches of His Grace

## Session 2 - Class 6 Notes

### ***Ephesians 1:3-12***

***Ephesians 1:6*** to the praise of the glory of His grace. Gracing us with grace in the Beloved.

***Ephesians 1:7*** in Him we have redemption through His blood the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.

***Ephesians 2:4-10 (7)*** that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

***1 Timothy 1:12-17 (14)*** and the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.

***Romans 3:21-26 (24)*** being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

Grace is to release control to God and trust Him for the outcome.

In testing we can go to Spirit or flesh, grace or works. We often justify ourselves rather than God and thereby force works, and right and wrong, to be our righteousness, instead of faith through Christ ***Romans 11:16***

### ***Galatians 3:1-14***

***Galatians 2:21; 5:4*** not to set aside the grace of God through self-justification in the law.

Where there is much law there is little love. Where there is much love there is little law.

***Ezra 1-6*** Two stories with the same people bringing two different outcomes—One being shut down the other completion.

***Zechariah 4*** Spirit of Grace changed the outcome for Israel.
