Session 4 – LEADERSHIP - Class 1 Notes

Luke 22:24-30 (27) Yet I am among you as the One who serves.

John 13:1-17 (3, 4) Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself.

Philippians 2:5-11 (5-7) Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery, to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, but taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

This is the opposite spirit of Lucifer, who wanted to be like God. He said in his heart, "I will ascend into heaven...I will be like the Most High." **Isaiah 14:13-15**

John 6:15 Therefore when Jesus perceived that they were about to come and take Him by force to make Him king, He departed again to the mountain by Himself alone.

Matthew 11:25-30 (29) Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly of heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Philippians 2:14-18 (17) Yes, and if I am being poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all.

Philippians 2:19-24 (19,21) I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy you shortly,...For I have no one like-minded who will sincerely care for your state. For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus.
