

Making Disciples

Session 4 – LEADERSHIP- Class 4 Notes

Matthew 28:18-20 *Go and make disciples of all the nations.*

We follow Jesus! Jesus did not say, "Follow Me to such and such a place, or state, or existence." He simply said, "Follow Me." Jesus is the destination; everything else is scenery.

We yield to Jesus so we can lead in Jesus.

CONSCIENCE

1 Timothy 1:5 *Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, a good conscience, and from sincere faith.*

1 Timothy 1:19 *Having faith and a good conscience.*

1 Timothy 3:8-13 (9) *Holding the mystery of the faith with a pure conscience.*

Romans 2:12-16 (15) *Who show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and between themselves their thoughts accusing or excusing them*

Hebrews 9:14 *How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot or wrinkle, purge our conscience from dead works to serve the living God?*

Hebrews 10:1-4 (2) *For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshippers once purified, would have had no consciousness of sin.*

Hebrews 10:22 *Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience.*

Romans 9:1 *I tell the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit.*

Acts 23:1-5 (1) *Men and brethren, I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day*

Acts 24:16 *This being so, I myself always strive to have a conscience without offense before God and men*

SUBMISSION / Yielded Souls

Philippians 3 (17) *Brethren join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern.*

1 Peter 5:5 Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."

2 Chronicles 7:14 if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Psalms 139:23-24 Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; ²⁴ And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.

Isaiah 30:15 For thus says the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel: "In returning and rest you shall be saved; In quietness and confidence shall be your strength."

But you would not,

James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

2 Corinthians 8:1-9 (5) Moreover, brethren, we make known to you the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia: ² that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality. ³ For I bear witness that according to their ability, yes, and beyond their ability, they were freely willing, ⁴ imploring us with much urgency that we would receive the gift and the fellowship of the ministering to the saints. ⁵ And not only as we had hoped, but they first gave themselves to the Lord, and then to us by the will of God. ⁶ So we urged Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also complete this grace in you as well. ⁷ But as you abound in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us—see that you abound in this grace also. ⁸ I speak not by commandment, but I am testing the sincerity of your love by the diligence of others. ⁹ For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.

FAITHFULNESS

Acts 6:1-7 (3) Therefore brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

2 Timothy 2:1-7 (2) And the things which you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit thaws to faithful men who will be able to teach others.

We commit to faithfulness over ability.

1 Corinthians 4:14-17 I do not write these things to shame you, but as my beloved children I warn you. ¹⁵ For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet you do not have many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. ¹⁶ Therefore I urge you, imitate me. ¹⁷ For this reason I have sent Timothy to you, who is my beloved and faithful son in the Lord, who will remind you of my ways in Christ, as I teach everywhere in every church.

Philippians 2:19-30 But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged when I know your state. ²⁰ For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state. ²¹ For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus. ²² But you know his proven character, that as a son with his father he served with me in the gospel. ²³ Therefore I hope to send him

at once, as soon as I see how it goes with me. ²⁴ But I trust in the Lord that I myself shall also come shortly. ²⁵ Yet I considered it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, fellow worker, and fellow soldier, but your messenger and the one who ministered to my need; ²⁶ since he was longing for you all, and was distressed because you had heard that he was sick. ²⁷ For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. ²⁸ Therefore I sent him the more eagerly, that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less sorrowful. ²⁹ Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness, and hold such men in esteem; ³⁰ because for the work of Christ he came close to death, not regarding his life, to supply what was lacking in your service toward me.
