

# Revelation the Book of Worship

## Session 3 – Revelation - Class 2 Notes

The Revelation of Jesus Christ is a book of worship. Jesus is seen and heard.

**Chapter One** - Jesus is heard and seen, John falls down, and rises in a new revelation of Jesus Christ.

**Chapter Four** - John is called up into the Throne Room and beholds God on the throne. The four living creatures cry out day and night, "*Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!*"

*Revelation 4:9, 10<sup>9</sup> Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, <sup>10</sup> the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: "You are worthy, Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."*

**Chapter Five** - is the appearance of the Lamb to move redemption forward. Now the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fall down and sing a new song. *Worthy is the Lamb!*

**Chapter Seven** - is worship in heaven with the saints maturing, fed, and led by the Lamb, who is in the midst of the throne.

**Chapter Eleven** - worship now points to the kingdoms of the world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ. Christ's authority being executed. ***Psalm 2*** and ***110***

**Chapter Fifteen** - the overcoming saints singing the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb! Subdued dominion from His judgments manifested.

**Chapter Nineteen** - the marriage of the Lamb, His omnipotence reigns the bride has made herself ready.

**Chapter Twenty-one** - the holy city of God, a new Jerusalem coming down out of heaven prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

**Chapter Twenty-two** - the river of life from the throne, the saints before Him, His name on their foreheads. *The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!"*

After each revelation of Jesus Christ comes worship. From worship comes more revelation and then activation as heaven initiates movement on the earth.

Seals, trumpets, thunders, and bowls move forward each after a worship session recorded above.

God initiates everything. The devil only copies what God is doing.

Practice taking the worship sessions, reading them as your words. We activate the Holy Spirit and truth when we approach God with a believing heart and confessing mouth. Go from one session to the next. Is there a worship session that captures you? Then spend time there and experience the revelation of Jesus Christ. Stay and drink of the fountain of the waters of life. Enjoy.
