Matthew 16 keys of the kingdom of heaven to open and lock doors and overcome hell's strategies

As Mankind, we each have the authority to welcome the Lord's authority into all areas of our sphere of authority. We also have the authority to resist the Lord's reign.

Matthew 16:13-28 Keys of the Kingdom in the revelation of Jesus Christ

Luke 22:31-34 *Simon, Simon! Satan has asked for you that he can sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you that your faith should not fail, and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren.*

John 21:15-22 *Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me more than these? Feed My sheep. Follow me.*

Revelation 3:14-22 *Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing"—and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked—I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire...*

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come into him and dine with him, and he with Me.

We can open the door and let the Lord in or ignore His voice and leave Him outside and ourselves in sin's deception.

Jesus gives us the keys of the Kingdom of heaven and we give Him the keys of our heart so that He fills all and all.

I take my authority and open myself entirely to the Lord's rule. I receive all of Him into all of me. I receive His fullness filling all of me. I step into my place in His body, which is the church the fullness of Him who fills all in all.
