Matthew 12:10-17 and turn, so that I should heal them.

Acts 28:25-28 The Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah

Romans 8:28-37 If God is for us, who can be against us. He did not spare His own son.

Engage—Encounter—Exchange

Isaiah 61:1-3, Luke 4:16-30, Acts 10:34-48

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

The Art of Receiving: I bring all of me into all of You and I worship. I receive all of You into all of me and receive your health. Union in Christ, receiving all with Christ.

When we receive Christ, we receive His grace. His grace is sufficient. **2 Corinthians 12:9**

It is contentment, enough. **Matthew 25:9; Philippians 1:19**

Sufficient: apparently a primary verb (but probably akin to 142 through the idea of raising a barrier); properly, to ward off, i.e. (by implication) to avail (figuratively, be satisfactory):--be content, be enough, suffice, be sufficient.
